

FACTS	WHAT DOES MedMaxFinance DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
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Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons MedMaxFinance chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

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Who we are

Who is providing this notice?	This notice is being provided by MedMaxFinance and applies to all ACCESS Card's for cardholders and the products and services offered in connection with those cards.
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What we do

How does MedMaxFinance protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does MedMaxFinance collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open an account or use your ACCESSCARD.• Give us your contact information or pay your bills.• Provide employment information. We also collect your personal information from others, such as affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal laws give you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness.• Affiliates from using your information to market to you.• Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions

Affiliates	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A financial or non-financial company related by common ownership or control. MedMaxFinance affiliates include all Healthcare providers who are currently enrolled in our membership card program.
Non-affiliates	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A non-affiliated financial company who engages in an agreement with another non-affiliated company to market products or service to you as the cardholder. MedMaxFinance joint marketers include financial lenders and insurance companies.
Joint marketing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A financial or non-financial company not related by common ownership or control. Examples of non-affiliates that MedMaxFinance shares information with include financial service providers, retailers, direct marketers, publishers and non-profit organizations.
